

Front Wheel





Back Wheel Hub

JOHN DEERE GINGERBREAD TRACTOR

ASSEMBLY GUIDE

- Place both tractor sides (1,2) face up on your counter.
- Attach wheels to tractor sides by applying frosting to the back of the front wheels (3,4), back wheels (5,6) and back wheel hubs (7,8).
- Once frosting has firmed up, flip tractor side (1) over, face down.
- Attach tractor bottom to tractor side. Apply frosting to the edge of the bottom (17) and a stripe of frosting along the lower edge of the tractor side (1).
- Place the bottom (17) on the tractor side. Use something to help support this piece while frosting sets.
- Attach these additional body pieces in the same fashion by applying frosting to the edges, the tractor side and adjoining pieces. **Tip:** thicker frosting will help pieces stand and stay in place.
 - Grill (15)
 - Back (16)
 - · Lower hood (12)
 - · Upper hood (11)
 - Back top (14)
 - · Front window (9)
 - · Back window (10)
- Once frosting has firmed up a bit, add frosting to the top edges of all pieces in the last step. Place the second tractor side (2) onto the body face up.
- Allow frosting to set (see your frosting instructions). This may take awhile, so be patient!
- Once frosting has set, set the tractor upright and apply frosting to the top edge of the cab. Then place the cab top (13).
- · Now it's time to decorate as you wish. Enjoy!

Note: You may want to prepare two batches of gingerbread dough to ensure you have enough.
